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Kawempe Home Care (KHC) is a community based, non-government organisation started in 2007 to provide comprehensive care to persons living with HIV/ AIDS, TB and cancer in Kampala and Wakiso districts.

The organisation provides HIV/TB services through an outpatient, outreach clinic and a home-based care service for patients with advanced HIV disease. Palliative care services are also provided to patients with cancer through the outpatient clinics and the home-based care service. We also provide a psychosocial support through the New Hope Children's hostel for poor and vulnerable children with cancer to enable them access to specialist pediatric oncology care at the Uganda Cancer Institute.

The organisation uses a community-based model of holistic care that addresses the physical, psychological, spiritual and social needs of each patient.

The main purpose of the job: To provide professional counselling, guidance and HIV testing services to enhance positive behavior change among clients and ensure to implement UNADS/PEPFAR's strategy of 95,95,95. To support sustainable HIV/AIDS epidemic control in our catchment area

Key roles and responsibilities

- To provide HIV testing and counselling services to clients.
- To create awareness about TB, HIV/AIDS control and stop further spread in the community.
- Ensure that self-testing services are provided appropriately to achieve set targets.
- To counsel and allocate positive clients to community volunteers for proper adherence follow up.
- To provide intensive adherence sessions to unsuppressed clients.
- Facilitate behavior change and life skill workshops for children, adolescents and most at-risk populations.
- To provide positive living education to clients.
- To provide EMCT counselling services to clients.

- To provide counselling to discordant and concordant couples.
- Ensure that clients form post-test clubs for care, support and AIDS awareness.
- Provide child counselling to children supported by KHC.
- To actively participate in continuous medical education training sessions.
- Ensure that each client file has a clearly filled locator form.
- Actively participate in client disclosure and ensure confidentiality of client's information.
- Make monthly and quarterly reports timely.
- Any other work-related duty assigned by the counselling coordinator.

Desired education and training requirements:

- A Diploma in either Guidance and counselling, Psychology or from a recognised institution.
- At least one years' experience in a similar position.
- Certificate in HIV/AIDS counselling from a recognized institution is a Must
- Good communication skills and interpersonal skills.

Other skills required:

- ✓ Self-motivated and willing to learn.
- ✓ Fluent in English and Luganda
- ✓ Good team player
